One Thousand People Charity Dinner (23rd October 2011)

Thrangu Dharma Society Petaling Jaya organised a 1000 People charity dinner to raise funds for the construction of its new Monastery Building on 23rd October 2011 at 7.00pm in Thean Hou Temple, Kuala Lumpur. The monastery named Thrangu Vajra Vidya

Monastery, will be built on a state allocated land in Damansara Perdana. The evening was attended to a full house and there were Dharma performances and songs together with screen projections about the new Temple project. We also took the opportunity to celebrate Thrangu Rinpoche's 79th birthday.

Thrangu Dharma Society Petaling Jaya (TDSPJ) was

established officially on 17th February 1989 on the instructions of Very Venerable Thrangu Rinpoche. After 22 over years TDSPJ will be moving into its new chapter of building its own new Temple. The total development cost of this project is estimated to be 10 Million Ringgit. The construction costs have included many variables related to hill slope development, slope and erosion stabilisation, environmental impact criteria and green building concepts (the location is situated on a hill slope). The costs also include final fittings, consecrations, images of various sizes, furnishing and equipment. The completion date is expected to be in 5 years, from submission of building plans and approvals, fund raising, to final construction period. The time could be shortened depending on source of funds. The Society is also applying for tax exemption, from the Government, for donations towards this project.
